



## 10 Questions to Consider

**As you think about developing an online program and/or prepare for your initial consultation, consider these starter questions:**

1. What current online program (if any) exists within your school district?
2. What do you feel is your district's immediate need regarding online course offerings for students? What are the online needs of your students? How do the two compare?
3. What is the current climate/culture with teachers and building administration when the topic of developing an online program is discussed?
4. Will the school district want to offer online courses for credit recovery, enrichment, or both?
5. Will the school district want to run the online courses using a synchronous or asynchronous model?
6. Is it the hope of the school district to develop your own online courses, or to purchase courses through a vendor?
7. What is the driving force for the development of an online program?
8. How many students currently reside within your district boundaries, but attend out-of-district online schools?
9. Do you have any teachers and/or administrators currently employed in the district who have experience with K-12 online learning?
10. What is the district's one year vision for an online program? Five year vision? Ten year vision?
